

# EMANCIPATION

HAS THE CHILD REACHED 19 YEARS OLD?

NO



No emancipation. If the child is 18 and does not meet any of the factors, the burden is on the non-custodial parent to make an application for emancipation.

Is there more than one unemancipated child?

Is the child support unallocated?

Does the child whose emancipation is in question meet any of the factors?

YES



Emancipation is not presumed. The non-custodial parent must make an application to the court. Child support will then be recalculated for the remaining children.

The child is presumed to be emancipated and obligation may cease without a court order.
